

INTRODUCTION



At the initiative of the Interim President of the O.M.J. Jean Pierre Rotzetter, under the direction of interim responsible Jorge Quintas, a meeting of expert judges of type canaries was held. The following countries were physically present: Italy, Portugal, the Netherlands, Uruguay, Spain and Serbia. By ZOOM: France, Brazil and the United Kingdom. Germany was represented by a written vote sent before the meeting. These 10 countries met in special conditions imposed by the covid 19 pandemic, on December 3, 2021 in Istanbul (Turkey) to establish the update of these standards:

The work they have done has allowed us to establish this document, which must be an important reference for all O.M.J. judges and for all breeders.

We hope that it will allow good harmonization among all member countries.

- White background
- 100% Lipochrome

Except for:

Cinnamon Class: When existing, all cinnamon must go inside it, including variegated or melanine, intensive or non intensive unless existing intensive class, crest or non crest without white ground. *Also includes all other different melanine*: agate, isabel, pastel, jaspe, satinette, phaeo etc., without white ground.

Lancashire (only lipochrome)

Characteristics

Typical color of the variety according to the standard.





Pigment analysis (from the poephila monograph)

Considering that color is not a physical property of the objects around us, but rather a decoding of our brain that receives and processes certain information from the environment (electromagnetic waves that affect the field of view).

In fact, each of us distinguishes the different chromatic tones thanks to our entire visual system perceiving the range of reflected waves in space that determine the spectrum of vision.

Therefore, before analyzing this part of the judgment sheet, it is essential, both for a correct evaluation of the subjects, to understand the genetic mechanism of their mutations, and to know that the coloration is given by the pigments and the special structure of the plumage.

The pigments are distinguished in:

- ➤ **Lipochromes**, which attributes coloration by means of carotenoids acquired from the diet:
 - Astaxanthine red color
 - Lutein yellow color
- ➤ Melanins, which in turns are distinguishes by :
 - Eumelanin, which attributes to the plumage, depending on the concentration, the colors that go from black to dark brown;
 - Pheomelanin, which attributes to the plumage, depending on the concentration, the colors that range from rust to yellow.

Lipochrome

Lipochromes are fatty pigments, which are generated in the bird, according to their diet, are deposited in the feathers, giving them their relative specific color. They are soluble in oils and fats. This dye is also observed in vegetables and called carotenoid, it gives rise to the yellow and red colors of the feathers. Different tones of lipochrome, depending on the concentration of it on the pen, generate precise gradations on the interested parts.





Melanin

Melanins are the other major group of pigments that give color to animals. It is a dark pigment, which is found in some cells of the body of animals. The main biological function is to protect individuals from ultraviolet rays, absorbing harmful radiation and transforming energy into harmless heat through a process called ultrafast internal conversion. This property allows melanin to dissipate more than 99.9% of the radiation absorbed by heat. These pigments are produced by the body, unlike lipochromes which are incorporated according to their diet.

Black eumelanin

Black eumelanin is a pigment present in all species of their ancestral variety. As the name suggests, it gives the bird black tones, provided that the feathers have a normal structure that allows them to absorb all the light waves they receive. As in lipochromes, black eumelanin can have infinite shades depending on the degree of presence in the feather. The more concentrated the pigment, the more black, intense and shiny tones will be obtained.

All feathers have the keratin layer, which covers the central area of the feather, where melanic pigments are located.

Brown Eumelanin

Brown eumelanin is given by a mutation. This mutation causes an alteration of the enzymes involved in the process of melanogenesis, reason why they are verified changes in it and the ancestral black eumelanin, becomes brown.

By itself, this pigment has the same characteristics as black eumelanin. The only variation is the tone it will bring to the bird's plumage. Similarly, under the normal structure of the feather will produce brown and/or brown shades.





As with black eumelanin in brown we can find infinite amounts of shades, which vary from the lightest to the darkest depending on the degree of concentration of the pigment that the feather possesses, ranging from very dark brown in cases of high concentration and tone, to light beige or cream in areas of great dispersion.

Pheomelanin

Pheomelanin, like black eumelanin, is found in almost all birds in their ancestral (classical) form.

It is the most interesting pigment to analyze given the wide range of shades it offers us depending on the degree of concentration, but mainly because unlike the pigments already considered (shades and tones in the same color range) pheomelanin has different colors (ochre yellow, rusty red, light brown, etc.) and each of them with a minor or major degree of expression, depending on the concentration of the pigment on large feathers and / or small feathers (example of small feathers, chest and back).

As well as the effect of light waves first absorbed by the feather and then refracted.

Shape and Size

Characteristics

Typical shape and size of the variety according to the standard.

Penalizing defects that do not correspond to the standard of the breed:

➤ Size : smaller or larger

➤ Head : flat or to small, or on the contrary too large and heavy in proportion with the body

> Back: concave or convex not corresponding to the standard of the breed

➤ Chest : flat or narrow or prominent and massive

> Trunk: too thin or too massive

➤ Legs : too long with a thin tibia and visibles thighs, or too short or covered with plumage from the abdomen.





Way of measuring the size of a canary	
For breeds of normal position, are measured by the existing distance between the top of the head and the tip of the tail.	
For breeds with angular position, it is the sum of the lengths from the tip of the beak to the highest part of the shoulders plus the length of this part of the shoulders to the tip of the tail.	
For elliptical breeds, it is the sum of the lengths formed from the tip of the beak to the shoulders, from there to the base of the tail and from there to the tip of the tail.	
For "bowed" breeds it is the length of the arc from the top of the head to the tip of the tail.	

Plumage

Characteristics

The plumage consists of feathers and quills. It should be complete, intact, uniform, smooth, compact, tight and shiny (Except for frills canaries).

The feathers will have to overlap each other like well-ordered tiles.

The tail and wings should be compact, closed and intact.





Penalizing defects that do not correspond to the standard of the breed:

- ➤ Plumage too long and abundant, making the mantle less compact.
- > Plumage too abundant on the flanks, eyebrows too bushy and marked.
- > Split in the throat and on the chest
- > Loose plumage on one or both flanks, abdomen or chest
- > Rooster feathers (except in some frill canaries and the Crest)
- ➤ Back with feathers that tend to separate
- ➤ Short and sparce plumage (except in Gibber, Giboso and Giraldillo)
- ➤ Not finished moult
- > Remiges and rectrices not uniform (with regrowthing feathers)
- ➤ Broken remiges and rectrices (wings and tail)
- ➤ Wing feathers not complete and not uniformly in-line
- > Fan or/and swallow tail are considered "serious defects"

Maintenance and Position

Attitude and position of the bird, in movement, not amorphous.

Characteristics

By position, we mean the attitude of the body of the subject and how it presents itself on the perch in the cage.

So the form and position, often compare and influence each other. A canary in which the form leaves something to be desired will hardly have a good position and vice versa. Excellent form can be summarized as: strength, pride and vivacity.

There are two types of penalty faults:

- 1. Character
- ➤ Wild or restless
- > Shy and fearful





2. Structural

- > Wings carried too low and slack along the body
- ➤ Crossed wings
- > Tail carried too low with a concave or convex tail body line, not corresponding to the standard

Condition, Well-being and Impression

A bird will have a good impression if it presents itself clean and healthy.

Condition of the bird:

- Short beak
- · Nails taken care of
- Health of the bird

Impression:

- Cleanliness of the cage
- Well-being of the bird

Stamm Definition

To be recognized as a stamm of color canary or type canary, the 4 birds that form it will have to be of the same breed, variety and type and be absolutely identical between them at the level :

- The background color, including the difference between intensive and non-intensive (or mosaic).
- The melanin color (classic or mutation have to be the same in the 4 birds).
- Sex (if visible dimorphism)

In case of non-conformity, each bird will be judged normally, but no harmony will be awarded. Only the total sum of points for the four birds will be recorded, but whatever the result, the stamm will not be awarded a medal.

In posture canaries, although the above mentioned basilar uniformity requirements are maintained, the following are accepted in stamm.

- Lipochrome stamm:
 - A stamm composed only of pure lipochrome birds (no melanin spots will be tolerated)
- Melanin stamm :
 - A stamm composed only of pure melanin birds (no lipochrome spots will be tolerated).





Variegated stamms:

All shapes of variegation are accepted in 1 stamm if the 4 birds presented have more or less the same proportions of variegation so that they look alike. (A stamm must be as uniform as possible).

Exceptions are the Lancashire, the Rheinländer and the German Crested, where the melanin is limited in the crest. For melanin German Crest, they must be 100% melanin, including the crest.

The Lizard, where the location of the melanin is well defined on the body, beak and legs. In this case, the type of "cap" design must be respected: all with the "Clear or almost clear cap", or all with the "broken cap", or all with the "Non cap or almost non cap".

Melanin is accepted in the beak, feet, toes and nails of lipochromes except for German Crests. For lipochromic canaries the melanin plumage is limited to the crest.

Will be accepted:

In stamm:

Lipochrome stamm: 100% lipochrome.

Melanin stamm: 100% melanin.

Only melanin spots in lipochromes and lipochromic spots in melanins on legs, beak and nails will be accepted. The exception are the "German Crested" where the color is judged according to the criteria of the color canaries.

Lipochrome variegation in the crest of melanin crested canaries will be considered variegated canaries.

Variegated stamm:

All forms of variegation are accepted in stamm, as long as all 4 birds have the same proportion of variegation. They must also have the same melanin and the same background color.

If melanin spots are only found in the crest of crested canaries, these will be considered as 100% lipochrome.

These rules are also valid for birds exhibited in individual classes.





Harmony

General considerations:

A stamm is composed of 4 (four) subjects which, as part of the competition, must be of the same phenotype "Type, Category, Variety, Sex".

If the judge does not find these considerations, he must in any case judge all the subjects, which will not be considered as a stamm and therefore will not give points of harmony to this stamm and will be excluded from the competition.

Harmony: 6 points available.

The harmony of a stamm is defined by 6 points minus the difference between the subject with the highest points and the lowest points.

Criteria for Non Judgement

Criteria for Non judgement (NJ):

- Partial or total lack of a limb, one or more toes, one or more nails.
- Deformed foot(s), stiff toe(s).
- One-eyed or blind.
- Significant lack of rectrices and/or remiges.
- Presence of melanin feathers (except in the crest) in Lancashire, Rheinlander or in lipochrome German Crest.
- Presence of lipochrome feathers in the Lizard (except in the cap) or in the German Crest melanin.
- Presence of one or more white nails in a Lizard or in a Black German Crest melanin.
- Presence of artificial pigmentation in breeds where that is not allowed.
- Obvious presence of plumage cyst ("lumps").
- > Atypical bird.
- Injured and/or sick subject.
- Any subject with combination of several breeds.
- Any cases not included or not provided for above will be submitted to the Control Commission.

Criteria for Wrong Class

Criteria for Wrong Class (Declassé - DC):

Any bird presented for judgment in the wrong class must be downgraded (DC). It will be necessary for the judge to indicate the right class in which the bird should have been registered.

The bird is judged on the basis of the criteria of the right class where it should have been registered.

The bird in this situation, even if it has an assigned rating, will not receive any award.

If one or more birds are in the wrong class in a stam, then they are not considered a stam.

All birds will be judged, there is no total rating referring to the stam nor the note of the harmony of the stam, there are only the individual notes of the birds (in the judgment sheet must be indicated the correct class of the bird/s registered incorrectly).

In the event that all the birds of the stam are of the same class and are incorrectly registered in another class, they actually constitute a stam and the final notation of the stam is added as well as the harmony, but they will be considered wrong class (DC).

In both cases, regardless of the final rating, no prize will be awarded to these birds.





Criteria for Disqualification

Any indication in the bird or in the cage that is relevant to be understood as a situation of manipulation or attempt to identify that bird. The bird will not be judged and the acronym - DQ (disqualified) will be placed on the judgment sheet.

Criteria for Disqualification (DQ):


- Whenever a sign or marking of a bird or of a cage is visible. For example: bird with more than one ring, absence of the ring, ring with irregularity (open, unofficial, etc.)
- Any exogenous alteration/manipulation of the bird that involves tampering with its characteristics influencing its competitiveness. For example, feathers handled, glued, cut and/or painted.









Portuguese Harlequin

Standard

Points	Descriptions
Body (shape) Chest/Wings 20	Elongated body, slender with slightly visible shoulders. Chest slightly rounded. Back narrow, straight, in line with the tail. Long wings, well adhered to the body and without crossing or drooping.
Crest / Head / Neck 15	The Crest (Crested Harlequin) - triangular shape (2 angles behind and 1 virtual in front) radiating from a central point at the top of the cap and dropping, adherent and symmetrically, without covering the eyes and beak. Head (Non-crested Harlequin) — Head narrow, elongated, wider behind than in front. Strong and proportionate beak. Bright and clearly visible eyes. Well-defined and harmonious neck, making the head clearly stand out of the body.
Size 15	16 cm / 6.3 inches.
Color 15	Balanced variegated with the simultaneous presence of red and chalk white lipochrome, having bright red in the characteristic areas of the mosaic red factor. The resulting sexual dimorphism is characterized by a greater extension of red lipochrome in males than in females. Artificial colouring is mandatory.
Position / Movement 15	Erect and majestic position (60°). Body well raised and head raised. Cheerful birds with agile movements.
Plumage 10	Smooth, compact, silky and well adhered to the body.
Legs and Tail 5	Strong, long and slightly bent legs, preferably variegated. Well visible thighs. Tail long, narrow and slightly bifurcated at the end, preferably variegated.
General Condition 5	Perfect health and hygiene. Vivacity and good adaptation to the show cage.



German Crest (Deutsche Haube)


Standard

Points	Descriptions
Crest 30	The crest corresponds to the shape of the head, which is oval. It starts from a small and distinct central point. Seen from the side the crest partially covers the beak and extends to the nape of the neck. The passage of the crest into the plumage of the nape of the neck is smooth with no gap. The eyes remain visible.
Color 20	The characteristic of the color is the same as for the Color canaries (are judged according to the respective standard of the color canaries). No variegation is allowed. Lipochromes can have a lipochromic, dark, grizzled crest. The presence of pigment in the crest of lipochromes cannot exceed the limit of the nap of the neck which is characterized by an imaginary straight line that passes between the mandibles and the eye.
Type and Size 15	The shape and type of the bird are identical to those of the color canaries. The wings, well adhered to the body without crossing each other. The size is 13.5 cm / 5.31 inches up to 14.5 cm / 5.70 inches.
Plumage 15	Smooth and well adhered to the body. Narrow and slightly forked tail, length according to the length of the bird.
Position 10	Alert, but not worried. Forming a 45° angle.
General condition 10	The bird is clean and shows itself in good condition.




Points	Descriptions
Dorsal design (Spangles) 30	The design of the back is formed by small scales, in the shape of a half-moon, perfectly aligned and separated from each other, enlarging towards the base of the wings. It is highlighted, with the background color that appears between each design. The spangles are dark as possible. Eumelanin should be oxidized (as black as possible). The presence of brown is to be penalized. The design must be visible in the broken part of the cap.
Chest design (Rowings) 15	The chest design is slightly more attenuated and wider. Drawn from the underside of the beak to the base of the tail, the rowings remain clearly visible, aligned and increasing in size towards the belly and flanks.
Feather quality 15	Very shiny, perfectly adherent to the body and not rough at all.
Ground Colour 10	Yellow, white or red. The ground colour is regular and uniform. Golden yellow for intensive and straw yellow for silver. The non intensive effect must be very well distributed. Red coloring allowed. The darker the better. The blue lizard, it exists as a dominant color and so the eumelanine is dispersed in the plumage and mixes with the white ground colour giving a tight and relatively short bluish-gray impression.
